What is the IN2 Youth Support Programme?

The IN2 Partnership is a local consortium of providers led by Landau to offer a programme of provision across the Marches LEP area. This covers Telford & Wrekin, Shropshire and Herefordshire.

The programme is funded by the European Social Fund (ESF) with match funding provided via the Education and Skills Funding Agency (ESFA).

The aim of the programme is to promote economic and social inclusion which seeks to achieve the sustainable integration of young people into the labour market.

Our goal is to help young people to participate in work or learning, by equipping them with the personal and transferable skills needed for work.

There are two categories of young people eligible for support through this programme:

- Those aged 15-16 who are at risk of disengaging from education. These are defined as “at risk of NEET”. Eligibility has to be recorded and requires consultation with a recognised third party or Institution associated with the young person (including school, employer, training provider or LA) and as a result of that consultation there is a reasonable basis for concluding that the young person is at risk of becoming NEET.
- Those aged 16-24 who are not in education, employment or training (NEET).



Our organisations mission is to empower young people from disadvantaged background or who struggle in a education environment to believe in themselves, meet their sense of belonging and make positive steps to become the best version of themselves.

Bright Star Boxing Academy began in 2016, and in this time has supported many people who have either come to us voluntarily or been referred through agencies such as the Police.

We have used boxing as a way of breaking down behaviour and developing new skills, guiding people through a young leaders Boxing Qualification.

Our programme helps increase confidence and teaches discipline.

We currently offer boxing sessions to: males struggling with poor mental health, women that have been victims of abuse, looked after children, young people at risk of offending, substance misuse and young people at risk of being expelled.

We have seen how boxing along with the right mentor can have a life changing impact to these people and how it can give respect, goals and stability to lives that need it most.

In the last 12 months Bright Star have been awarded the Thrive Mental Health award and has recently received three nominations for the National Street Games.

Bright Star have also recently been awarded a Queens Award for Voluntary Service, the highest award a voluntary organisation can get, in recognition of their work with vulnerable people.



Southall School



Southall School is a Secondary Special School for pupils with a range of moderate and complex needs. At Southall, we place the needs of our students at the heart of all we do, this includes providing a bespoke package of support for our Year 11 pupils to support in successful transition from school into post-16 education or employment.

At Southall School, we aim to support the development of our pupils holistically, from academic progress to developing life skills.

This approach is embedded throughout the curriculum for all our pupils and is differentiated based on their individual needs.

An important part of our curriculum is preparation for adulthood.

This begins in Year 7 and progresses towards Key Stage 4, where it is personalised to reflect pupil's prospective pathway, interests, and needs.



This has been extremely successful and has been recognised by Southall School becoming the first provider in Telford & Wrekin and The Marches to be awarded the Gold Award against The Gatsby Benchmarks.

In Year 11, we provide an increased programme of support, providing pupils with opportunities to meaningfully experience potential post-16 placements.

We have found this to be extremely helpful in supporting pupils in 'bridging the gap' between school and college, and a vital step in making this transition successful.

Pupils take part in weekly careers sessions, have regular talks with local education providers and employers, and work on personal skills such as CV writing, interview techniques and applying for jobs.

In all that we do, we aim to support pupils to become as successful and independent as possible, and our preparation for adulthood programme is a vital part of this.
