

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MG'S STORY - BEECHTREE

Michelle aka Shell walked into the Beechtree in August 2021 and was initially signed up for the BBO project where she did a resilience course. She then signed up to Time for You to prepare for employment.

She had lost confidence in her abilities after time away from the workplace and after being a carer. She had also experienced the bereavement of her partner and of two close family members in a short space of time. She had become anxious and fearful during the pandemic and was hiding behind her long hair and wearing a face mask. She couldn't hold eye contact and was wary about speaking.

Her goals were to update her CV and prepare for going back to work in her chosen career of horticulture. She wanted support to set goals and build her confidence around being with other people and in her own self esteem. She wanted IT skills training as she had her own laptop.

She felt that she had lost her sense of identity and she also needed to come to terms with her bereavements.

She planned to make changes to her appearance and to her physical and mental health which she knew would take time. She needed support with making these changes.

Initially under the BBO programme, she attended a Resilience training course with us that helped her to be part of a group and gain peer support. She also undertook an IT with Employability City and Guilds course.

Shell was due to continue on the project and has finished early but she has exceeded her goals and has gained her sense of identity and purpose. She is brimming with confidence and achievement.
