COMMUNITY GRANTS CELEBRATION EVENT

We held two wonderful events this month celebrating the success of the Community Grants project since it's launch in January 2020.

Funded by the ESF, the aim of the scheme has been to provide targeted support to small and voluntary organisations in the way of grants for initiatives which help move unemployed people, aged 18 and over, towards employment, training or education.

In Shropshire, the Community Grant scheme has funded 46 different projects and supported over 600 individuals. In Herefordshire, the Community Grant scheme has funded 31 different projects and supported 334 individuals.

"Without the Community Grants scheme, we would have not been able to help so many people turn their own lives around. The legacy of this project is that it has been life-changing for so many people."



Craig Howard, managing director of Anta Education Ltd attended the Landau celebration event to speak about his own experiences of mental ill health and how the business had been supported by the Community Grants scheme to support others struggling with their mental health.

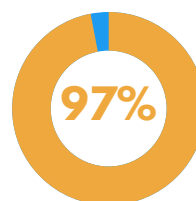
OUTCOMES

Community Grants team go pumpkin picking!

To support Landau's Sustainability team, we would like to offer you a small gift of pumpkin seed to grow your own. Please see the tips to help you get started!

When to plant - The best time to plant pumpkin seeds is from late May to early July. Once I begin to sprout, you can plant me outside with lots of room and continue to water me.

Pick a Planting Site - Pick a site with full sun to light shade, keep me in a warm environment and keep in mind that the soil should be able to drain because pumpkins prefer soil that is not too soggy.

Water Early in the Morning - Watering in the early morning is key, especially if kept in a warm environment like indoors while starting the growing.
