WHAT IS IN2?

IN2 is an employability and personal development programme for 15 to 24-year-olds who are at risk of NEET or NEET.

This programme focuses on developing young people's employability and key life skills to take control of their own lives and move towards a better future.

The IN2 programme equips young people with basic and employer led skills, providing them with the support to move into sustained education, employment, or training, through traineeships or apprenticeships.

Todd clearly enjoyed the course and received guidance from the Construction tutor on jobs and future employment within the construction industry. Todd was encouraged to work towards a L1 Extended Certificate in Construction Skills which he completed which is a massive achievement and will open lots of opportunities for him – well done!

SCHOOL OF CODING




